The contract will implement recommendations emanating from the energy-efficiency study funded from SFA 2006. The contract therefore, includes the supply, delivery and installation of energy-saving technological supplies for approximately 5 existing government/public buildings within Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. The supplies include bulbs, ballasts, air conditioning, and insulation materials and a refrigeration system to use more energy-efficient hydrocarbon refrigerant. The supplier is expected to honour an obligation in terms of warranty for the supplies.

The contract is divided into lots:
Yes, number of lots: 4.
Lot 1: energy-efficient lighting devices (bulbs, ballasts, occupancy sensors, etc.).
Lot 2: supply and installation of natural lighting systems where applicable.
Lot 3: supply and retrofit/upgrade of existing air conditioning and refrigeration systems to use more energy-efficient hydrocarbon refrigerant.
Lot 4: supply and installation of roof insulation material to reduce heat gain on building roof tops.
