2 Review of Scope of works

<u>Lot 1 - Rehabilitation of Grand Sable River Bridge</u>

- Establishment of a by-pass road including a temporary metal bridge
- Construction of abutment and wing walls to accommodate temporary by-pass bridge
- Demolition and reconstruction of existing Grand Sable bridge in its entirety (40 ft span) and associated wing walls
- Realignment/integration of roadway and drainage to suit the configuration of the new bridge and its related structures

Lot 2: Rehabilitation of Congo Valley Road, Bridge and River Defenses

- Demolition and reconstruction of the existing bridge no. 1
- Realignment / integration of the roadway and drainage to suit the configuration of the new bridge and its related structured
- Realignment of both sides of the Grand Sable River using gabion baskets (approx 1300 ft)
- Miscellaneous road works, etc.
